## Protection of personal data

## **6. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT**

6.2. You have the right at any time to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data given to the Administrator. However, this is without prejudice to the lawfulness of processing your personal data prior to such withdrawal of consent.
